# FAQ

1. When do I have to submit my application?

July 10<sup>th</sup>

2. What are the fees?

There is a \$10 entry fee. If you do not have a California Sellers Permit, or you want SP Arts to process your credit card sales, a 20% commission will be charged.

3. When will I get paid for artwork sold at the show?

Our volunteer treasurer will mail checks out 10-15 days after show.

4. What time is set up?

You can set up between 11:00 am and 1:00 pm on July 19<sup>th</sup>. You will receive a participant pass to show at 6<sup>th</sup> and Centre to get into the closed portion of 6<sup>th</sup> Street. However, all cars must be out of the festival area by 1:00 pm. Parking is available underneath the 6<sup>th</sup> Street Lofts and at the Courthouse parking lot.

5. Will I need my own easel, table and chairs?

Yes, artists are responsible for their own display setups. Also bring a sun umbrella or canopy if you want some shade. Sandbags or weights to keep the canopies from blowing down the street are advised.

6. Will I be responsible for my own clean up?

Yes. Trash receptacles will be provided by Crowne Plaza.

7. Will there be food and drinks for sale?

Yes, the Crowne Plaza will have various BBQ food items and soft drinks for sale on the restaurant patio. You are welcome to bring your own refreshments if you want.
